On the weekends during the harvest season, seventeen year old Chris and his family hunt rabbits in the sugarcane fields of the Florida Everglades.

Synopsis

In the Florida Everglades rabbit hunting is considered a rite of passage for young men. The Rabbit Hunt follows seventeen year old Chris and his family as they hunt in the fields of the largest industrial sugar farms in the US. The film records a tradition by which migrant farm workers in the communities surrounding Lake Okeechobee have been hunting and preparing rabbits since the early 1900s.

Directors' Bio

Patrick Bresnan is a visual artist and filmmaker. He received his formal education working for notable Mission School artists Clare Rojas and Barry McGee (TWIST) before directing his short documentary THE SEND-0FF, which premiered at Sundance 2016 and received awards at SXSW, AFI FEST and San Francisco International Film Festival. That year, he and his partner lvete Lucas were named among Filmmaker Magazine's 25 New Faces of Independent Film. THE RABBIT HUNT, his follow up short, premiered at Sundance 2017 before competing at Berlinale, and won ten awards, including Best Documentary at four Academy-qualifying events. Bresnan and Lucas are currently directing a feature documentary titled PAHOKEE, which takes place in the Florida Everglades.
